

RAINBOW SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT FUND GUIDELINES

The interest earned from the Rainbow Scholarship Endowment Fund is to be used for Scholarship Grants to benefit ACTIVE members of the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls, who are in good standing and residents of the State of Florida for at least two years. Scholarships will be awarded based on money available in the fund, *please note that all applicants will not be awarded a scholarship.* The scholarship grant is to assist them in securing a College, University, and Commercial or Professional education, in accredited schools of learning, preferably in the state of Florida. Although the scholarship grant is a gift, it is requested that the girls' fortunate enough to receive this help will repay the amount received, and more, when they are gainfully employed. Other Rainbow Girls may then have the opportunity to receive financial help.

To apply for a grant you must print the scholarship application from the Florida Rainbow website @ www.fliorg.org/forms. Before submitting your application for approval, please be sure that you have complied with all the rules and regulations set forth herein. Each item on the application must be thoroughly completed.

The student receiving aid shall be of good moral character, with limited financial resources; willing to help herself within reasonable limits; be in good health; able to meet the entrance requirements of the school or college she wishes to attend. She shall submit a properly certified report of the scholarship standing of the preceding semester. The application must include the name, address, and date of birth of the applicant, the school of learning she plans to attend, and the course of study she plans to follow. The application must be accompanied by three letters of recommendation, one from her Mother Advisor, the others from her pastor or Sunday school teacher, a school principal or teacher, or some other person who knows her very well and who is not a relative. In addition, the student must furnish a brief Rainbow background, i.e., date of initiation, offices held, honors received, etc. Information such as school and church activities will be helpful.

If you wish to apply for a grant for your second, third or fourth year, you must request a form each year, complete and return your application by May 15th of this year. The decision of the committee will be announced at Grand Assembly.
