GUIDELINES FOR GRAND ASSEMBLY

1. **Traveling pin:** Every Grand Representative has a traveling pin. If you do not, please let me know. If you find for any reason you will not be able to attend Grand Assembly, please give your pin to your Grand Deputy, Mother Advisor or me. Your pin is the property of Grand Assembly. Be sure to bring your pin to Grand Assembly. You will be responsible to pass your pin, with a small gift, to the next Grand Representative. If you lose your pin, you need to replace the pin at your expense.
2. **Report:** Your Grand Representative report is very important. The deadline for me receiving your report is May 1st. Please e-mail your report to me mompris@aol.com. You should type one page, not more than 300 words, no personal thank you, only information of your state or country.
3. **Costumes:** We will have a parade of costumes. There are a few restrictions.
 - α. All costumes must be in good taste.
 - β. Do not wear anything that will restrict your ability to walk, use your arms.
 - c. Create a costume relating to your State or Country.
 - δ. You must handle your costume without help you must walk without assistance.
 - ε. Your costume cannot be rented or made by a professional person.
 - φ. No tapes, we want to see you, not hear you.
6. **Flags:** Your flags will be at Grand Assembly. Be sure to know what it looks like.
7. **Sash:** Your Grand Assembly sash is given to you at Grand Assembly when your Grand Assembly pin is collected.
